



- NOTES:**
1. CONTRACTORS MUST SUPPLY DRAWINGS TO COLUMBIA GAS 30 DAYS PRIOR TO ANY DISTURBANCE ABOVE, BELOW, OR WITHIN THE 50' RIGHT OF WAY OF THE GAS LINE. NO WORK CAN COMMENCE UNTIL THE DRAWINGS ARE APPROVED BY COLUMBIA.
 2. BLASTING WITHIN 300 FEET OF THE GAS LINE MUST BE APPROVED BY COLUMBIA GAS PRIOR TO COMMENCEMENT. A BLASTING PLAN MUST BE SUBMITTED TO COLUMBIA 30 DAYS PRIOR TO PROPOSED BLASTING ACTIVITY. COLUMBIA MAY REQUIRE PRE AND POST SEISMIC CHECKS AT VARIOUS LOCATIONS.
 3. COLUMBIA GAS SHOULD BE NOTIFIED SO THEY CAN BE PRESENT WHEN DISTURBANCE OR BLASTING ACTIVITIES ARE TAKING PLACE.
